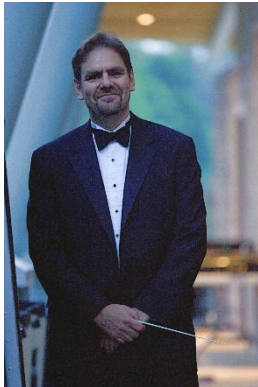

Andy Brick: Principal Conductor and Music Director



Andy Brick is an award winning composer, conductor and symphonist of music for film, video games and live concerts including The Sims, Civilization, Warhammer, Mafia, Little Mermaid II, Lady & The Tramp II, and Sinbad. He has composed, conducted and orchestrated both live concerts and recorded soundtracks for such notable games as Super Mario Bros., Halo, Final Fantasy, The Sims, World of Warcraft, Elder Scrolls, Undertale, Civilization and others.

In 2003 Brick set a historic milestone conducting the Czech National Symphony Orchestra at the Gewandhaus Concert Hall in the western world's first symphonic game music concert.

Andy served as the principal conductor and music director of the ensuing concert series from 2003–2008. From 2009–2014, Brick was Principal Conductor and Music Director of the highly celebrated Play! A Video Game Symphony.

At the close of that series, Brick was asked to create a new concert series that featured the artistry of the symphony orchestra and in January, 2020 Maestro Brick premiered Game ON! with the National Symphony Orchestra of the United States to a exuberant house at the historic Kennedy Center in Washington D.C Since then Brick and Game ON! have delighted audiences with over 30 concerts on 4 continents!

As a champion of symphonic game music, Brick has conducted a multitude of game soundtracks with orchestras including The Seattle Symphony, The National Symphony Orchestra (US) (2X), The Czech National Symphony (5X), The Vancouver Symphony (2X), The Hallé (2X), The National Symphony Orchestra (UK) The Calgary Philharmonic, The Toronto Symphony and others and has been featured in the New York Times, Billboard Magazine, the BBC, Global News Canada, ITV, the CW TV network and Symphony Magazine.
